**Key to Soil Moisture:** D = Dry, DM = Dry Mesic/Well drained, M = Mesic/Medium moist, WM = Wet Mesic/Medium moist to soggy, W = Wet/Soggy or marshy

**Key to Light Levels:** FSU = Full Sun, PSU = Part Sun, PSU = Part Shade, LSU = Light Shade, SH = Shade, WSH = Woodland Shade
